Following a long delay, the Walford Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan is making progress once again. A new steering group has been established led by parishioner Andrew De la Haye. In the short period that the new group have been together they have obtained funding for the first stages of the project and engaged specialist planning consultants to help take the project forward to conclusion as rapidly as possible.

As with any Neighbourhood Development Plan the involvement of parishioners is key, both in the construction of the plan and in the final voting to determine whether the plan should be adopted. With this in mind, two relaunch meetings have been organised:
